About Zeta



Levels Description

A101

Students are expected to master sounds and reads and writes Arabic diacritics. They can introduce themselves in simple terms that would give the following info: Name, age, gender, occupation, and residence. They can also differentiate between the singular and plural forms in Arabic as well as names and verbs.

A102

Students are expected to master sentence structure in Arabic (nominal, verbal), verb tenses in the past, present, and future and their negation. Students can give a more advanced introduction: What they like, their hobbies, and things they prefer.

A201

Students are expected to start using present continuous and past continuous, and to use the simple form of stipulation, interjection, and comparison. Using these tools, they can express what are the best and worst thing to them.

A202

Students are expected to learn how to describe and express state, using state rules, adjective sentence and they will be able to write long paragraphs using conjunctions.

B101

Students are expected to be proficient in Arabic and they can rephrase a text's idea in their own style using Arabic. They are also expected to distinguish directive verbs and their negation.

B102

Students are expected to differentiate verb meanings in Arabic based on form, and to be able to derive new words after studying forms of derivation.

B201

The students are expected to be able to correct a verb tense and to derive from it, and to be able to read newspapers and discuss its contents or to discuss what's on the radio.

B202

Students are expected to be familiar with advanced linguistic forms and expressions and to study irregular forms such as the fourth root, color forms, and the functions of (Ma) in Arabic.

C101

Students are expected to be familiar with advanced linguistic forms and expressions and to study irregular forms such as the fourth root, color forms, and the functions of (Ma) in Arabic.


Curriculum


