- Al-'Arabiyya is now accepting submissions for consideration for publication in Volume 57 (2024). For submission guidelines and to submit your paper, click here.

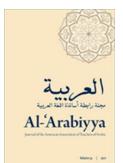

Religious Allusions and Expressions in Arabic Literature in English Translation

Call for Submissions Deadline: February 10, 2023

One of the challenges faced by translators of Arabic literary texts into English concerns the approaches used in rendering embedded religious content and allusions. In this panel, we invite presentations that focus on the strategies used by translators to convey the meaning of religious expressions, allusions, and symbols in a manner that takes into consideration the compatibility between the linguistic and conceptual planes. We would also like to address the strategies that translators of Arabic literature use to find equivalence and substitutes for particular Qur'anic connotations and implications in the source language and culture and their counterparts in the target language and culture.

In this AATA panel held in conjunction with MESA's 57th annual meeting on November 2-5, 2023, in Montréal, Canada, we would like to focus on the rhetorical strategies and linguistic choices used in translating religious allusions and expressions in Arabic literature in English in relation to the following topics:

- Strategies of semantic and syntactic approximations
- Adaptation and naturalization of culturally specific expressions
- Cultural, pragmatic and text specific problems
- Idiomatic expressions with religious allusions
- Functional equivalents and cultural substitutes.

We invite presenters interested in presenting on any of these or similar issues relevant to the panel topic to send a 300-word abstract and a short bio by Friday, February 10, 2023, to aatapanel@gmail.com

Accepted presentations should be delivered in Arabic.

الكنايات والعبارات الدينية في الأدب العربي المترجم إلى الإنجليزية

الموعد النهائي لتسليم الملخصات هو: 10 شباط/فبراير 2023

أحد التحديات التي يواجهها مترجمو النصوص الأدبية العربية إلى الإنجليزية يعلق بالأساليب المستخدمة في تقديم المحتوى والعبارات والكنايات الدينية المضمنة. في هذه الندوة ندعو الباحثين إلى تقديم أبحاث تركز على الاستراتيجيات التي يستخدمها المترجمون لنقل معنى التعبيرات الدينية والكنايات والرموز بطريقة تأخذ في الاعتبار التوافق بين المستويين اللغوي والمفاهيمي للغتين. نود أيضا أن نتناول الاستراتيجيات التي يستخدمها مترجمو الأدب العربي لإيجاد التكافؤ والبدائل لدلالاتٍ وإشارات قرآنية معينة في اللغة والثقافة وما يقابل ذلك في اللغة والثقافة الثانيتين.

في هذه الجلسة التي ترعاها AATA في الاجتماع السنوي السابع والخمسين لمنظمة MESA الذي سيعقد في الفترة من 2 إلى 5 نوفمبر 2023، في مونتريال، كندا، نود التركيز على الاستراتيجيات البلاغية والخيارات اللغوية المستخدمة في ترجمة الكنايات والإشارات والعبارات الدينية في الأدب العربي باللغة الإنجليزية فيما يتعلق بالموضوعات الآتية:

- استراتيجيات التقريب الدلالي والنحوي
- و تكييف أشكال التعبير الخاصة ثقافيّاً وتجنيسها
- المشاكل الثقافية والبراغماتية والنصية المحددة
 - العبارات الاصطلاحية مع التلميحات الدينية
 - المعادلات الوظيفية والبدائل الثقافية.
