- Al-'Arabiyya is now accepting submissions for consideration for publication in Volume 58 (2025). For submission guidelines and to submit your paper, click here.

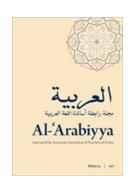

- 5. الابتكارات التربوية: أحدث الاستراتيجيات لتعزيز تدريس اللغة العربية لغة ثانية ، مثل التعلم القائم على المهام ، والفصول الدراسية المقلوبة ، وغير ذلك.
- التقويم والتغذية الراجعة: استخدام التكنولوجيا في التقويم وتقديم التغذية الراجعة.
